PURIM	March 13	March 2	Purim is a happy holiday celebrating the rescue of the Jews in Ancient Persia. It's a fun day with parties and feasting.	Fruit-filled Golden Blintzes make a perfect sweet Purim dessert, like apple, cherry or blueberry.
PASSOVER	April 12	April 1	Passover is an 8-day holiday that commemorates the exodus of Jews from Egypt 3,000 years ago. It's both a celebration and a reflection of freedom.	Golden products do not carry a kosher for Passover designation and would not be promoted during this 8-day period.
SHAVUOT	June 1	May 21	Shavouth is a happy 2-day event marking the end of the grain harvest. It's also the day Moses, was given the Ten Commandments. Dairy and Pareve foods are in big demand.	Stock up on delicious Golden Cheese Blintzes for this holiday.
ROSH HASHANAH	Sept 22	Sept 11	Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish New Year. Festive family meals are an important part of this 2-day holiday.	All varieties of Golden Blintzes and Potato Pancakes are suitable for this celebration.
YOM KIPPUR	Oct 1	Sept 20	Yom Kippur is a day for fasting and prayer. A family meal is eaten prior to the holiday. The fast is broken after sunset the following day.	Golden Cheese Blintzes are the perfect light meal for breaking the fast.
SUKKOT	Oct 6	Oct 6	Succoth celebrates the fall harvest for one festive week. Meals are enjoyed outdoors, usually inside the Succoth, to symbolize how the Jews lived during their journey from Egypt 3,000 years ago.	Celebrate with all of Golden's fruit-filled and potato blintzes.
CHANUKAH	Dec 14	Dec 4	Chanukah is the Festival of Lights – an 8-day celebration of a battle, victory and the miracle of one day's lamp oil lasting for 8 days. It's a happy time with many parties and gift giving.	Latkes, which are potato pancakes, are symbolic of this holiday. So make sure you're well stocked on Golden Potato Pancakes.
